1. Binders: A 3-ring binder is mandatory for this course. All class notes, projects, handouts, articles and chapter questions will be kept in this binder. Nothing gets thrown away!!!! Every assignment, handout and project should be kept in the binder.
2. Daily Requirements: You need to bring your binder and a writing utensil with you to class each day. A highlighter, colored pencils and a pencil sharpener are also recommended.
3. Please do not use red or randomly colored ink for any graded assignment.
4. All homework must be done on a full size piece of loose leaf or computer paper.
5. All assignments will be collected at the beginning of each period on the date assigned for full credit. Any work not turned in at that time is considered late. 10% will be taken off for each day late. Absences will be taken into consideration.
6. Absences: If you are absent, you need to see me as soon as possible to turn in work or to schedule any makeup work. Missing class but being in the building on the day of a test, quiz, or even a due date for homework does not excuse you from that day's assignment. Absenteeism is not an excuse for being unprepared.
7. If you know in advance that you will be missing class/ school please let me know in advance so that we can work out assignments.
8. Every student will be responsible for a year-long major project that will be a graded. More information to follow.
9. Electronics in the classroom is by permission only. Continued misuse of personal devices will result in disciplinary action based on school policy.
10. Lateness is unacceptable. Habitual lateness will be handled by a phone call home. If the behavior continues, disciplinary action will be taken.
11. Academic dishonesty is absolutely unacceptable!!!! It is assumed that you will follow the academic integrity policy for the district.
12. We go outside as frequently as possible. I will try to let you know ahead of time so you can dress appropriately. It is assumed that behavior outside will be the same as behavior inside the classroom.
13. The greenhouse will be maintained by the students. A schedule for watering and other activities will be discussed at a later date.

14. At all times this classroom is treated as laboratory setting which includes in the classroom, in the greenhouse and outside. All safety measures must be taken at all times!!! These include but are not limited to; fooling around, eating or drinking, treatment of living organisms etc.
